

At Lori's School of Dance, we work hard to make learning a pleasant experience & conduct ourselves in a positive manner. Our staff believes that dancers should be versatile and well-rounded with a strong base in ballet technique. We strive to give every dancer the opportunity to develop and succeed in every aspect of dance. As teachers, we instill discipline & technique as well as life lessons in our methodology. We feel students should be dedicated to their dancing & feel proud of what they achieve throughout the year.

Registration Fee

A \$50 registration fee per student is required upon enrollment. This fee is non-refundable.

Vaition Rates & Payment Options

Tuition is billed on a monthly basis. Rates vary based upon the number of hours each student takes per week. Tuition payment is due on the 1st of each month and is considered late after the 10th of each month. A \$10 late fee or 10% of your bill (not to exceed \$25) will be added to all past due accounts after the 10th of each month.

Costumes will not be ordered for those students with a balance. No costumes, trophies, recital tickets, etc. will be distributed to those with a balance until fees are paid.

Sibling Discount: We offer a discount of \$5.00 off tuition for additional children in the same family.

- **CREDIT/DEBIT CARD (online)** For your convenience, **sign up for autopay!** Tuition & fees will be withdrawn on the 1st of each month (August fees will be withdrawn on the first week of classes). **Please note: there is a 3% surcharge when paying with credit/debit card.**
- CASH/MONEY ORDER (in studio) Bring your payment to an LSoD faculty member in studio. Please submit cash or money orders in a labeled envelope. Receipts will be emailed.

Annal Recital - June 6, 2026

The highlight of each dance year is the presentation of our annual revue! This performance gives all of our students the opportunity to showcase their individual accomplishments to their families and friends. It is the culmination of a year's hard work, and always so much fun. We will rehearse onstage at the River Center on **Friday, June 5 at 5:00 pm**. There are no costumes for the rehearsal—regular dance clothes, please!

Mark your calendars now, recital is Saturday, June 6 at 2:00 pm!

Costume Fees - 1/2 due in October, 1/2 in November

We order all our costumes for the recital from special costume supply companies. **Costumes are \$85** each, and costume fees will be split into 2 payments, with the first half due October 1st, and the remainder due November 1st. Teen costumes or larger sizes may exceed \$85. Each costume includes one pair of tights, and extra tights may be ordered at a later date if desired (sign-ups will go out in February/March for extra tights).

Costumes must be paid for in full and your account must be fully up to date before costumes can be ordered. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Late fees will be charged if paying for costumes after the November 1 due date.

Recital Fees - Due monthly with Parties

Putting on our recital is no small feat! Your recital fee helps to cover the costs involved in putting on our annual recital (River Center theatre rental, props, backdrops, special lighting, etc.).

With this fee, each family will receive one picture program book per dancer, a recital video link, 5 reserved seats in the theatre (+2 for each additional sibling), and a special award for each student to celebrate their achievements. We may also hire backstage workers as needed to monitor your dancers in the dressing room at rehearsal and on recital day. Parent volunteers are very welcome to help backstage – be on the lookout for more details as recital gets closer if you'd be interested in sitting backstage with your dancer's class.

The recital fee will be broken up into 10 monthly payments, due alongside tuition from August 2025-May 2026. The recital fee is \$20/month for families with 1 dancer, \$25/month for families with 2 dancers, and \$30/month for families with 3+ dancers.

Studio Achly Policies & Parent Observation Weeks

With the exception of the parents of our youngest dancers, our lobby will remain closed to help promote focus in the classroom as well as to keep crowd sizes down in-studio. We ask that parents and non-dance siblings drop their students off in the lobby at the start of class time (dancers aged 8 & under should not be left without an adult present). Please be assured that the LSoD faculty and class helpers are well-equipped to help each dancer, and we have your phone number on file in case of emergency.

Students should arrive no more than 5 minutes before the start of their class time, and should be picked up from the studio lobby or the sidewalk immediately following class.

PARENT OBSERVATION WEEKS: Even though our lobby & studio curtains will be closed the majority of the time, we are excited to invite parents into the studio to observe their dancer's progress six times during the dance year! Our studio curtains will be open for the duration of class on the weeks listed below.

Class Attendance & Withdrawal Policies

Good attendance is very important to us, especially in the months leading up to the dance recital. We are constantly learning new material and skills, and missing even a few weeks puts dancers behind. Dancers may have 1 absence per class enrolled in order to be awarded Perfect Attendance at the end of the season.

Dancers with excessive absences may not be allowed to participate in recital or may be required to take private lessons at \$25/half hour or \$50/hour to catch up on material missed. Please be in class as much as possible and only miss when absolutely necessary!

Class demonstrators learn a special dance to showcase their talents at recital. In order to participte in the demonstrator dance, students must have excellent attendance in all their regular classes and may not miss more than 5 demonstrator classes throughout the year.

Written notice must be given to withdraw your dancer from Lori's School of Dance. The deadline to drop a class without penalty is October 31, 2025. Parents of students dropping out of any class after 10/31/25 are responsible for all fees incurred through May 2026 (including any late fees) regardless of written notice given or the dancer's attendance in class. THERE ARE NO REFUNDS.

There may also be unforeseen cancellations due to weather. Please check your e-mail or our social media for all updates regarding class cancellations due to weather. If classes have to be cancelled more than once, extra make-up classes will be offered if a majority of the students are able to attend.



In order to provide a productive learning environment, proper dance attire is required. Students who are not following dress code may be asked to sit out of class.

Ages 7 & Under Ballet & Tap or Ballet, Tap & Jazz Combo Classes

Dancers will need:

- ★ Black leotard (\$22)
- ★ Pink footed tights (\$13)
- ★ Pink ballet shoes (\$27)
- ★ Black patent tap shoes (\$27)
- ★ Skintone jazz shoes (\$37)*
- **★ OPTIONAL:** ballet skirt (\$16)



* PLEASE NOTE: Dancers in Ballet, Tap & Jazz combos may wear ballet shoes for jazz & wait to order jazz shoes closer to recital pictures (February/March).

Ages 8 & Up Ballet, Tap & Jazz and Teen Combo Classes

Dancers will need:

- ★ Black leotard (\$22 child/\$24 adult)
- ★ Pink tights (\$13 footed/\$14 convertible)
- ★ Pink ballet shoes (\$27)
- ★ Skintone jazz shoes (\$37)
- ★ Black slip on tap shoes (\$52)



Musical Theatre, Contemporary, and Technique Classes

Dancers will need:

- ★ Skintone jazz shoes (\$35)
- ★ Leotard & tights or fitted DANCE CLOTHES - no baggy clothes will be permitted.

Modest crop tops are permitted, but no bra tops should be worn.



Hip Hop Classes

Dancers will need:

- ★ Clothes they can move in
- **★** Tennis shoes or sneakers

Tumbling & Technique Classes

Dancers will need:

- ★ Leotard & convertible tights or fitted DANCE CLOTHES
- **★** Bare feet
